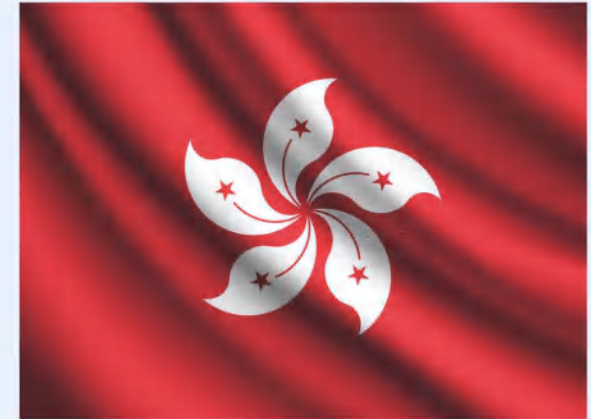

Geography

Hong Kong, full name as Hong Kong Special Administrative Region of the People's Republic of China, is located at the south of Mainland China at the Pearl River Estuary of the Asia Pacific, consisted of Hong Kong Island, Kowloon Peninsula and New Territories, at the opposite side of Shenzhen City, Guangdong Province and separated by the Shenzhen River. With a total land area of 1,106 square kilometers (427 sq. mile) and the total population of over 7.3 million with different race and ethnic groups, mainly are Chinese people, it ranks as the world's fourth most densely populated territory.

Politics

After the transfer of sovereignty of Hong Kong from British to the People's Republic of China in 1997, it became a Special Administrative Region with a high degree of autonomy. Under the principle of "one country, two systems", Hong Kong maintains a separate political system from China. Except in military defense and foreign affairs, Hong Kong maintains its independent executive, legislative and judiciary powers. In addition, Hong Kong develops relations directly with foreign states and international organizations in a broad range of appropriate fields.

Economy

Hong Kong is an international city, after New York and London, is the world's third largest financial center, enjoys a high reputation in the world. Hong Kong is Asia's leading financial, service and shipping center, with clean government, good security, freedom of economic system and the perfection of the legal system is famous in the world, in addition to the elegant nickname of "Pearl of the Orient", also have the reputation of "gourmet paradise" and "shopping paradise".

Brief of Hong Kong Immigration

Hong Kong used to implement relaxed and open admission policies. Hong Kong welcomes whether professionals or businessman to work or invest in Hong Kong. If oversea professionals are equipped with special skills, knowledge or experience needed and lacked by Hong Kong, or being to make great contribution to Hong Kong economy, they may apply to work in Hong Kong in accordance with the “General Employment Policy”.

In 2015, there were 34,403 oversea professionals got approval to work in Hong Kong in accordance with the “General Employment Policy” . People who got such approval of admission or stay in Hong Kong may apply their spouse and unmarried and dependent children under 18 years of age to live in Hong Kong with them in accordance with the current “Dependent Policy”.

All applications are processing in accordance with the laws of HK and the guidance of the Immigration Department

Project Introduction

1. General Employment Policy (Professionals)

Eligibility Criteria

- There is no security objection and no known record of serious crime in respect of the applicant;
 - The applicant has a good education background(a first degree in the relevant field), but in special circumstances, proven technical qualifications, professional abilities and relevant experience and achievements may also be accepted;
 - There is a genuine job vacancy;
 - The applicant has a confirmed offer of employment and the job relevant to his academic qualifications or work experience that cannot be readily taken up by the local work force; and
 - The remuneration package is broadly commensurate with the prevailing market level for professionals in the HKSAR.
- * The GEP is quota-free and non-sector specific.

2. General Employment Policy (Entrepreneurs)

An application for a visa/entry permit to enter the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region (HKSAR) for investment as entrepreneur may be favourably considered if:

- The applicant is in a position to make substantial contribution to the economy of the HKSAR, with consideration factors including, but not limited to,
 - A. business plan;
 - B. business turnover;
 - C. financial resources;
 - D. investment sum;
 - E. number of jobs created locally; and
 - F. introduction of new technology or skills.
- An applicant who wishes to establish or join in a start-up business may also submit an application.





Eligibility Criteria

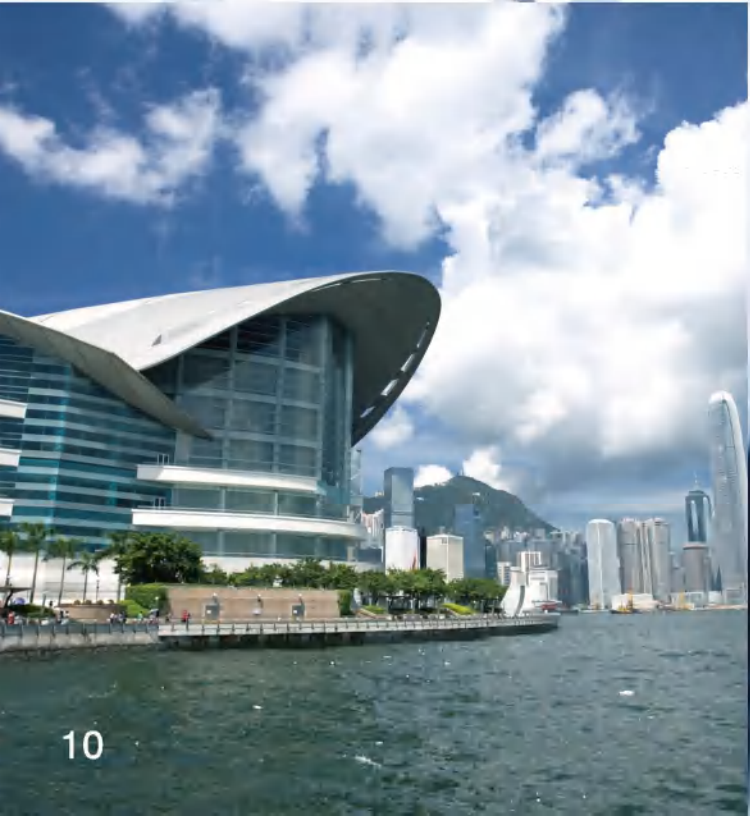
1. There is no security objection and no known record of serious crime in respect of the applicant;
2. The applicant has a good education background(a first degree in the relevant field), but in special circumstances, proven technical qualifications, professional abilities and relevant experience and achievements may also be accepted.



* Overseas Chinese nationals holding People's Republic of China passports who meet the criteria stipulated above and normal immigration requirements may apply to enter the HKSAR for investment if:

- The applicant has permanent residence overseas; or
- The applicant has been residing overseas for at least one year immediately before the submission of application

"Overseas" means places outside the Mainland, the HKSAR and the Macau SAR and that the application is submitted from overseas.





3. Admission Scheme for Mainland Talents and Professionals

Chinese residents of the Mainland of China (the Mainland) who possess special skills, knowledge or experience of value to and not readily available in the HKSAR may apply to come to work under the ASMTP.

An application for an entry permit to take up employment under the ASMTP may be favourably considered if:

- There is no security objection and no known record of serious crime in respect of the applicant;
- The applicant has a good education background, normally a first degree in the relevant field, but in special circumstances, good technical qualifications, proven professional abilities and/or relevant experience and achievements supported by documentary evidence may also be accepted;
- There is a genuine job vacancy;
- The applicant has a confirmed offer of employment and is employed in a job relevant to his academic qualifications or work experience that cannot be readily taken up by the local work force; and
- The remuneration package including income, accommodation, medical and other fringe benefits is broadly commensurate with the prevailing market level for professionals in the HKSAR.

* The ASMTP is quota-free and non-sector specific.

4. Quality Migrant Admission Scheme

The Scheme is a quota-based entrant scheme. Highly skilled or talented individuals who have not yet secured a job offer in Hong Kong but are interested to settle and work in Hong Kong may apply under the QMAS which has no sector restriction. There are two points-based tests, General Points Test (GPT) and Achievement-based Points Test (APT) under the scheme.



5. Immigration Arrangements for Non-local Graduates

Non-local graduates may apply under the IANG to stay in Hong Kong for one year to look for a job.



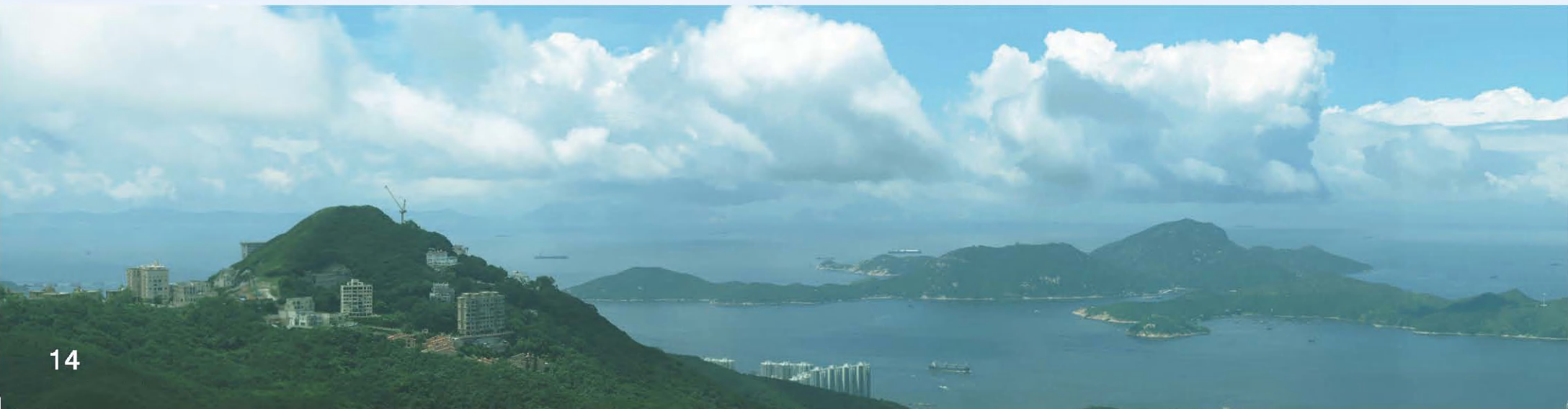
Key requirements include:

- Obtained an undergraduate or higher qualification in a full-time locally-accredited local programme in Hong Kong;
- Job offer not required upon entry (for fresh graduates); and
- Job is at a level commonly taken up by degree holders and is remunerated at the market rate (for returning graduates).

6. Admission Scheme for the Second Generation of Chinese HK Permanent Resident (ASSG)

Applicants, who are the second generation of Chinese Hong Kong permanent residents from overseas, may apply for entry into the HKSAR under ASSG. There is no sector restriction and no job offer is required upon entry. Key requirements include:

- Aged 18-40;
- Born in overseas (apart from China, Hong Kong, Macau and Taiwan)
- At least one parent holding valid Hong Kong permanent identity card upon application and was a Chinese national settled overseas at the time of applicant's birth;
- Good education background, technical qualifications or proven professional experience;
- Proficient in written and spoken Chinese (Mandarin or Cantonese) or English; and
- Have sufficient financial means.



7. Dependent and Stay Arrangements

For a sponsor who has been admitted into the HKSAR to take up employment (as a professional, for investment to establish/join in business) or studies (in a full-time undergraduate or post-graduate local programme in a local degree-awarding institution), or the Quality Migrant Admission Scheme or the Admission Scheme for the Second Generation of Chinese Hong Kong Permanent Residents, the following dependents may apply to join him/her for residence in the HKSAR:

* Dependent : his/her spouse; and his/her unmarried dependent children under the age of 18.

An application for admission of a dependent may be favourably considered if:

- There is reasonable proof of a genuine relationship between the applicant and the sponsor;
- There is no known record to the detriment of the applicant; and
- The sponsor is able to support the dependant's living at a standard well above the subsistence level and provide him/her with suitable accommodation in the HKSAR.

* Dependent should meet normal immigration requirements (such as holding a valid travel document with adequate returnability to his/her country of residence or citizenship; be of clear criminal record and raise no security or criminal concerns to the HKSAR; have no likelihood of becoming a burden on the HKSAR, etc.)

Condition of Stay

Dependents of the following persons are not prohibited from taking up employment in the HKSAR:

- persons who have been admitted for employment (as professionals, for investment to establish/join in business); and
- entrants under the Quality Migrant Admission Scheme or the Admission Scheme for the Second Generation of Chinese Hong Kong Permanent Residents

However, dependents of persons who have been admitted into the HKSAR to study are prohibited from taking up employment in the HKSAR unless they have obtained prior permission from the Director of Immigration.

All dependents do not require prior permission from the Director of Immigration to study in the HKSAR.

Other Services

8. Staying in HK for Studying

Eligibility Criteria

- The applicant is admitted to a registered private school. Except for post-secondary education, entry for study in public or aided schools is not permitted;
- The applicant takes up studies in a full-time locally-accredited post-secondary programme including short-term course or part-time locally-accredited taught postgraduate local programme;
- The applicant is admitted on exchange in full-time locally-accredited local programmes at sub-degree level for not more than 6 months or on exchange in full-time locally-accredited local or non-local programmes for not more than one year at undergraduate or above level; or
- The applicant is enrolled in a full-time course on the register of non-local higher education or professional courses as set up under the Non-local Higher and Professional Education (Regulation) Ordinance (Cap. 493);
- The applicant is from the age of 5 years and 8 months to 11 for primary education; or below the age of 20 for secondary education;
- The applicant holds a school acceptance letter to confirm that he/she has been accepted for a course of study; and
- The applicant is able to meet the fees for the course, the living expenses for his/her maintenance and accommodation without working and without recourse to public funds.

- * To apply for entry for study, the applicant should nominate a local sponsor. A local sponsor can either be the educational institution granting the acceptance or an individual. The sponsor should be financially capable to support the applicant and provide him/her with accommodation and is required to sign an undertaking for the aforesaid requirement and promising to send the applicant back to his/her originated residential area if necessary.



- * Besides, if the applicant is under the age of 18, one of the applicant's parents should authorise the sponsor in Hong Kong to be the guardian of the applicant. A consent letter duly signed by both the guardian and one of the applicant's parents should be produced.



9. Staying in HK for Training

An application for a visa/entry permit to enter the HKSAR for a limited period (not more than 12 months) of training to acquire special skills and knowledge not available in the applicant's country/territory of domicile may be favourably considered if:

- there is no security objection and no known record of serious crime in respect of the applicant;
- the bona fides of the applicant and the sponsoring company are satisfied;
- the sponsoring company is a well-established company, capable of providing the proposed training;
- there is a contract signed between the sponsoring company and the applicant;
- the sponsoring company guarantees in writing the maintenance and repatriation of the applicant and that the applicant will receive training in the sponsor's premises until the end of the agreed period, after which the applicant will return to his/her place of residence; and
- the proposed duration and content of the training programme can be justified.

10. Imported Workers

The Supplementary Labour Scheme (SLS) is implemented in the HKSAR to handle applications for importation of labour at technician level or below. Imported workers admitted under this arrangement are not allowed to bring in their dependents.

Process of Application

- Briefing of the Plan ;
- Assessment on the documents submitted ;
- Affirmation by our professional team (including Accountant and Lawyer) ;
- Contract sign and deposit pay ;
- Prepare all documents required and submit them to the Immigration Department ;
- Within 6 months, notification letter of approval of the application will be issued (pay the outstanding service charge within 3 working days) ;
- Accompany Applicant to the Immigration Office for ID Card's collection ;
- Continue the monitoring progress work for the three applications of extension in accordance with the contract signed ; and
- Continue our round-the-clock service .





Required Documents for Full Set 7-year Plan

Plan A: Including starting up a company

Principal Applicant :

1. Passport;
2. Identity Card/Birth Certificate/Household Register;
3. No Criminal Record Certificate
4. Highest Academical Proof/Special Skills Proof / Professional Proof, job related academic qualification and working experience proof (certificate, qualification certificate or reference letter, etc.);
5. Marriage/Divorce Certificate;
6. Personal Resume;
7. Photos (10) (Passport format photo);
8. One year of personal monthly bank statement; and
9. Any personal asset proof (including real estate, vehicle, investment, insurance, etc.)

Dependent (Spouse and children under age of 18)

1. Passport;
2. Identity Card / Birth Certificate / Household Register / Studying Proof.





Plan B: The Applicant has his own company

- 1. Except that the applicant prepares the company documents, finds an accountant and pays tax each year, the other services are the same with Plan A;**
- 2. To calculate the price mainly based on all the data and documents from the main applicant and Hong Kong company (China or oversea company);**
- 3. The more sufficient the documents are, the lower the price will be;**
- 4. Full set 7-year Plan includes the arrangement of three extensions; and**
- 5. Once the Hong Kong Identity Card has been issued to the main applicant, the Hong Kong Identity Card of the dependent will be issued within 3 months.**
